She stated there were a few Town Halls closing in light of this COVID-19 epidemic. She pointed out that the Town of Marystown had closed their Town Hall to the public but the residents could correspond by telephone or via email. There were concerns how the residents would pay their taxes and us closing while some businesses are staying open.
