The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the 2026-2027 Municipal Capital Works Program.

Be it resolved that we submit a Municipal Capital Works application for Thorburn Road Water/Sewer, Storm Sewer, Curb & Gutter Upgrades Project, totaling \$859,368.15, as priority 3.

Be it resolved, the Town Manager seek approval from a financial institution to borrow \$77,930.49 for the town's share of the Thorburn Road Water/Sewer, Storm Sewer, Curb & Gutter Upgrades.
