A quorum being present Mayor Blackmore called the meeting to order at 5:00p.m.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss whether or not to open our playgrounds and parks.

As stated in our previous meeting there have been numerous inquiries as to whether Lookout Park would be open for the season. Also, the playgrounds.

Due to the protocols put in place by the provincial government relating to the opening of parks and playgrounds, council felt that we would only open one park (Lookout Park) and one playground (the main one in Catalina) with sanitizing practices in place as stated by the provincial Chief Medical Officer.

Our Park Attendant stated that he would be able to sanitize Lookout Park and the Catalina Playground in the morning but would not be able to commit to doing it in the afternoon as he has other work to do around town. He suggested that maybe we could get volunteers to do the cleaning some days. It was decided to place an ad on our Facebook page seeking volunteers to disinfect the areas.

Thompson Park, Caul's Pond Park, the playgrounds in Melrose, Port Union and Little Catalina to remain closed. It will be revisited again if the Province goes to Alert 1.

Councillor Stagg stated she was approached by residents looking to see if they can play softball on the ballfield in Port Union.
