# 2025/26 Fire Protection Vehicles Infrastructure Program, Project No. FES-NL250008

A letter was received from the Department of Justice and Public Safety confirming that the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador have approved funding for Trinity Bay North Town Council for the purchase of a new firefighting vehicle with an estimated project cost of \$850,000, taxes included. The cost-sharing arrangement for this vehicle is based on an 80/20 Provincial/Municipal ratio, and the funding is approved on the condition that the Ultimate Recipient (Town of Trinity Bay North) is willing and able to meet its share of the costs.
